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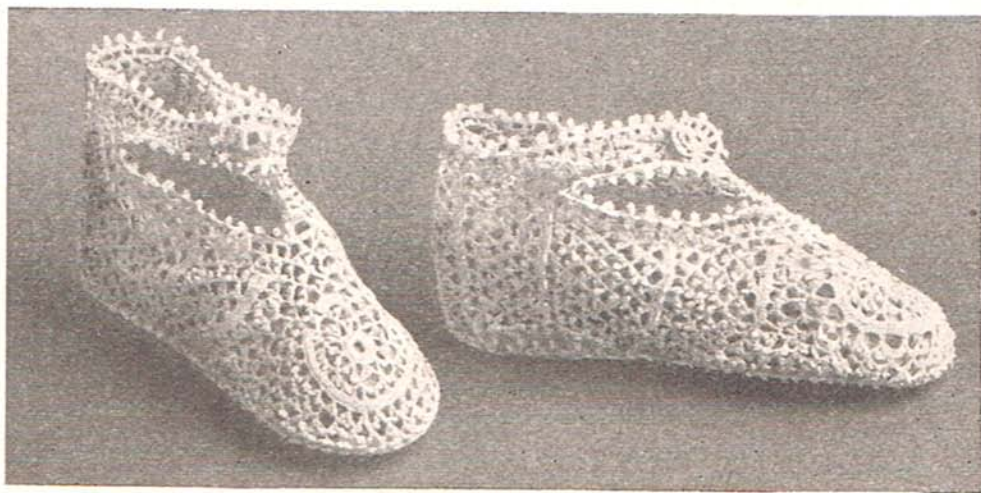
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*Bootees in Antique Lace Pattern*—Make a ring of padding and cover it closely with 28 single crochet. Join. On this ring work 2 rounds of picot loops, in the first round catching down in every third stitch of the ring.

Third round—Ch. 3, 1 d. c. after the second picot of loop last caught into, \*ch. 3, 1 d. c. in next loop before the first picot, ch. 3, 1 d. c. in center of same loop, ch. 3, 1 d. c. in same loop after second picot, and repeat from \* until 1 d. c. has been worked in the center of the fourth loop from the end of the round. Turn and in each of the holes just made work 4 s. c.; turn, 1 s. c. in each s. c., picked up on the double thread. Make 2 picot loops along the round, ch. 8, catch in the center of next loop, turn, 10 s. c. over the 8 ch., turn, ch. 2, 1 d. c. in each s. c., then work 2 rounds of picot loops, in the first of them catching along the s. c. bar in every fourth stitch.

Baste medallions in position on toes, then fill all spaces around them with the picot loops, until a straight row of the loops is worked across the top of the toe, from one side of the sole to the other. Now work along the sides and the back, alternately making 6 rows of picot loops and 1 row with a s. c. bar, making the latter as instructed for the toe medallion, and having the bar extend from the top edge to within 2 loops

of the bottom edge. Make straps and soles as instructed for other bootees and work top edge in the same way, excepting at the center of the front, where 3 scallops are substituted for the points made on the other bootees. These scallops are worked as follows, over the 6 center holes: \*Fill the first 2 spaces with s. c., turn, ch. 10, catch in first s. c. made, turn, in the new loop put 5 s. c., ch. 5 and catch for a picot, 5 s. c., picot, 5 s. c. Repeat twice from \*. For these bootees a ring is used instead of a button.
